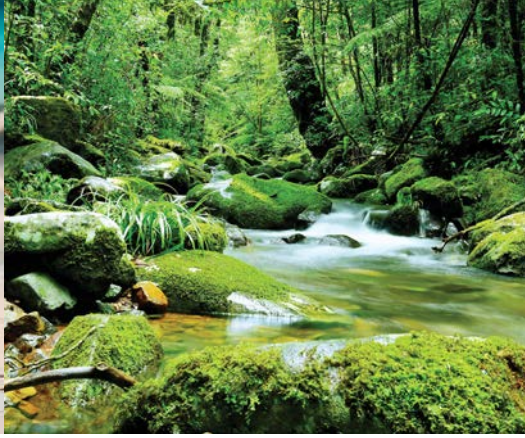

How you will learn

Our classes focus on practical English skills. Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing are integrated throughout the course. You will have many opportunities to practice your English and improve your English knowledge and skills. You will:

In-Class experience

You will be assessed at the end of every 5-week teaching session. The results of the assessment may enable you to move up to the next level of Integrated English. The typical student spends 10 weeks at each level.

The choice is yours

Students in Levels 3, 4 and 5 can customise their learning by choosing from three program streams: General English, Academic English and Business English. Best of all - you can create a personalised course of study by combining one of these streams with an elective of your choice.

General Stream

This is the standard option. General English classes will help you to develop your confidence with the English language. You'll increase your ability to understand conversations and speak with more fluency and clarity. You'll also build your skills to read and write with greater accuracy.

Academic Stream

Develop the skills and confidence you need to succeed in university. Increase your reading speed and comprehension, while learning to write clear and logical sentences, paragraphs and essays. Communicate effectively in conversation and when giving presentations. Develop your ability to express facts, ideas and opinions in academic writing, using correct and appropriate vocabulary.

Business Stream

Develop speaking, listening, reading and writing skills for a business context. You'll improve speaking skills through group and individual presentations and be able to actively contribute to meetings. Experience real-life business scenarios, become familiar with business terminology and practices, and learn to write various business documents used in the real world.

Select the stream that is right for you and your learning goals. If your enrolment is longer than 5 weeks, you will have the choice to continue in your current stream or change to a new one.

Customised Programs

English and Entrepreneurship Program

2 weeks

Programs for UQ College and UQ partner institutions

Are you a UQ College or UQ partner institution? We can co-design a customised Integrated English program for your students. Here are some possible programs.

Integrated English Plus – Cultural Experiences Program

Do you want your students to have an overseas experience that will improve their English and their cultural awareness? Students will study in Integrated English classes with students from around the world each morning. In the afternoon they will participate in cultural activities such as;

- Brisbane City walk
- Tour of the Brisbane River by CityCat
- Lone Pine Koala Sanctuary visit
- North Stradbroke Island day visit
- Australia Zoo visit
- Gold Coast and Sunshine Coast tours
- Whale watching boat tour

Health insurance fees

Student Visa Holders

If you are coming to Australia on a Student Visa, you need to purchase and maintain Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). OSHC is insurance that helps cover the cost of basic medical care you may need in Australia.

We can organise Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for the full length of your UQ College Program. If you arrange your OSHC through UQ, we will organise cover with our preferred provider, Allianz Global Assistance.

When you accept your program offer, you will need to pay an OSHC fee. You will then receive your policy number and details in your Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE).

Alternatively, you can also organise your own OSHC through any other government-approved provider. When you accept your program offer, you will need to provide evidence of your OSHC before we can send you a CoE.

Application Process

Individual students

Step 2	Receive your Letter of Offer and student portal activation link.
Step 3	Activate student portal, accept and pay the fees. Detailed instructions on how to pay are included in your Letter of Offer.
Step 4	Receive your orientation information via email and prepare for departure.

Step 3	Accept the proposal and pay deposit
Step 4	Provide group participant details to Program Services
