

Bespoke program structure

- Brisbane-based learning: Begin with an orientation and 2 days of inperson learning each month for the first 2 months at UQ's historic Brisbane City venue, guided by globally recognised academics and industry experts.
- Oxford residential: Midway through the program, you'll travel to Saïd Business School, University of Oxford for a 5-day immersive residential with your cohort. Enjoy site visits, curated activities and dining experiences and onsite accommodation, while engaging with international experts in transformative project work.
- **Return to Brisbane:** After Oxford, the program continues with another 2 months of 2-day, in-person sessions in Brisbane, leading into a powerful finale session to consolidate your learning, strengthen your connections and prepare you for lasting impact.

Eligibility to participate

The Transformative Project Leadership Program is designed for senior executives across the private and public sector who are leading complex initiatives, from capital projects to critical service delivery.

The program is open to leaders searching for capabilities above and beyond traditional project management training as well as people who may not consider themselves to be project professionals, yet their portfolios have hallmarks of project work.

The investment
