

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Admissions Pathway Application Form - Bachelor of Dental Science (Honours)

Background Information

The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Admissions Pathway is designed to assist Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander applicants who are interested in studying a Bachelor of Dental Science (Honours). In addition to gaining entry on the basis of an <u>Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR)</u> or equivalent, there is the opportunity to apply through The University of Queensland (UQ) for the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Admissions Pathway program.

The Admissions Pathway considers a range of factors in addition to formal education, such as your employment history, academic achievement, personal interests and references. Under the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Admission Scheme, it is possible for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander QTAC applicants to receive up to receive 5 automatic adjustments to their ATAR or Selection Rank. This boost can significantly enhance applicants' chances of admission to their desired program. Bachelor of Dental Science (Honours) applicants who apply via this Pathway, are not required to sit the University Clinical Aptitude Test ANZ (UCAT ANZ).

Entry Requirements

The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Admissions Pathway is available to people who:

- Identify as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person.
- Have listed UQ as a preference in their QTAC application.
- Have met the program prerequisites or equivalent[#]

#Applicants who have not completed the program prerequisites are required to demonstrate they have successfully completed equivalent subjects or have substantial relevant experience which is assessed by the respective Faculty as meeting the program requirements. Application Process

All applications require the following:

- Completed and signed Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Admission Pathway application form.
- <u>Confirmation of Aboriginal (CoA) and/or Torres Strait Islander status</u> from an incorporated community organisation. A statutory declaration accompanied by supporting materials may be considered. **Original or certified copies of CoAs and/or supporting documentation must be provided.** For more information contact the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Studies Unit at atsisaltentry@uq.edu.au.



• Academic transcripts and/or certificates of completions from previous studies.

Highly Desirable

- Reference letters evidence of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander community engagement.
- Supporting evidence of any academic, leadership or community service awards or achievements relevant to your application.
